I have to agree with Tom. If the material has been made available to VMworld attendees what's stopping it from going public?

I would have loved to attend VMworld but because of my location (Canada) air fare alone would cost \$2000 per person. Once you add the cost of registration and a couple of hotel rooms, you're looking at a \$10,000, 3 day seminar. Kind of hard to justify for some organizations.

Having to wait 3 to 6 months for the material to go public isn't suitable. By the time it is released, it will be either outdated or potential customers will have moved funding on to other products and projects.
