Yes - pre register for all the break-out sessions prior to arrival, this will guarantee a spot within the session. If you aren't registered for a particular session, you will have to stand in the non-registered line. Sometimes, these can be no problem, other times they can be around the block.

Labs especially - the good labs will fill up extremely fast, so make sure you register for all you can.... it's nearly impossible to get into a lab and be on a PC if you aren't registered for that particular lab.
